HISTORY

The *James & Dorothy Bamberg Scholarship* was established by the late Deaconess Dorothy Best Griffin Bamberg and her family. Deaconess Bamberg began her Christian training at the tender age of nine and continued to serve until her passing at the blessed age of 86. Deaconess Bamberg, along with her family, united with the New Laurel Street Missionary Baptist Church in 1955. Her profession of faith and love for the Lord was exemplified by her Christian service. She served in numerous capacities with the church as well as the community, receiving countless awards, various recognitions, commendation and plaques. Within the consecrated walls of this great church, Deaconess Bamberg served as a Deaconess, Sunday School teacher for forty years, Sr. Missionary member (president for sixteen years), Youth Advisor and the organizer and director of Christian Education, to name a few.

PURPOSE

Deaconess Bamberg's legacy is one of *'education and service'* and her greatest desire in establishing the scholarship was to provide financial assistance to a college bound freshman student who is not only a member of this church, but also a student who serves within this church.

REQUIREMENTS

In order to receive a \$250 one-time scholarship, the following requirements must be met:

\$250 Scholarship

1. Must be a member of New Laurel Street Missionary Baptist Church for at least eighteen months from the application deadline date.
2. Proof of GPA
3. Submit a 250 minimum word essay about your development as a Christian.

In order to receive a \$500 one-time scholarship, all of the requirements above must be met in addition to the requirements listed below:

\$500 Scholarship

1. Minimum 3.5 GPA, based on a weighted grading scale (an official transcript is required)
